Lake Treatment- many thanks to Monty and Dixie Fisher for allowing us the electricity to keep the tote heated to properly store the remaining treatment through the winter. We still have nearly ½ of the tote left. Ryan Brown will be treating the lake again this year and believes we should have enough to get through the season- yay!

We did have a short lived algae bloom the other day. We are hoping to be proactive rather than reactive in the treatments using early and light doses. The treatment we are using is most effective once the water temperature reaches a certain level.

Maintenance and improvements of the freeways and recreation areas- Lots of discussion about the need to maintain 2 boat launches (especially considering the cost of some of the needed repairs).

Lisa has been getting quotes for gravel and sand. Valerie may be able to get a little bit of a discount. Another suggestion was to build some sort of a jetty to keep the sand from the beach area from just washing into the lake. Tom Davis mentioned that some places also use pea gravel.

We have watercraft stickers for 2025. Once distribution starts please only ask for the correct number of stickers based on how many watercraft you have. They cost \$2.25 and we are trying to only purchase what is necessary to save money.

Aaron Huffman is prepping the spot to reinstall the port-a-potty and enclosure for this season prior to the Memorial Day celebration.

## New Business

Lisa reviewed the budget for 2025. Based on past years the dues collection is expected to be about \$12,800.00 with many association members not paying the required dues.

Expected expenses are approximately \$17,800.00 An example of costs was given by Tom Davis. Example: The cost of compressors for the aerators as gone from \$800.00 a piece to \$1200.00

The last time dues were raised was 15 years ago! There was much discussion regarding raising dues and it looks like it is necessary based on the budget shortfall. Anyone in good standing with the association will have the opportunity to vote on an increase in dues. Ballots for the vote a coming.
